Team shield

- Individual
- Pairs
- Small group
- Whole group

Uses: To help create a team identity.

Resources: Paper; pencils; colours; rulers; possibly old magazines and newspapers; glue etc. Images of family crests or heraldry.

Time: 15-30 minutes.

What to do:

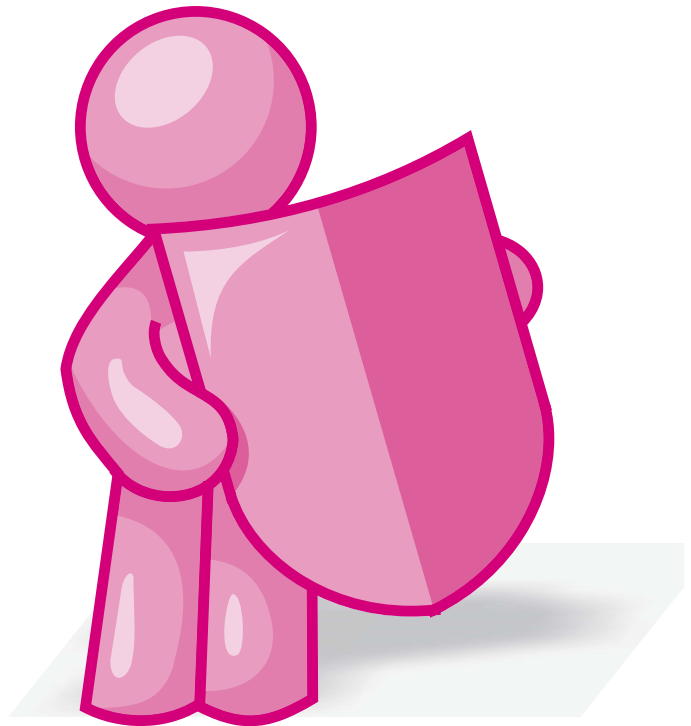
1. Work in small teams – three-four people is ideal.
2. Explain that the task is to create a team shield, as a group.
3. Ask the participants to allow some planning time before they embark on making their shield.
4. Time for making.
5. Each group displays and explains their shield – or the rest of the group can try to interpret it first before it is explained.

Make it different:

- For a longer activity/project – each person designs their own shield first, and then as a team they work to combine the shields together. You can make links with heraldry and family crests here.

Points to make:

- Using metaphor and representation is an excellent tool for thinking and memory.
