



## Starter

# Odd one out!

- Individual
- Pairs
- Small group
- Whole group

**Uses:** A quick and easy starter for developing thinking skills around a topic.

**Resources:** Pre-prepared cards or lists of words. These can be very obvious, or better still, less obvious and with more than one 'right' answer.

**Time:** 10 minutes.

### What to do:

1. Issue the pre-prepared cards to small groups of participants.
2. They discuss which word is the 'odd one out', and why.
3. If time, get feedback from the groups.

### Make it different:

- Do this as a whole-group activity. The participants make their own cards and challenge other groups.

### Points to make:

- Making connections is a key learning activity.
- Being able to argue your point is a crucial skill.
